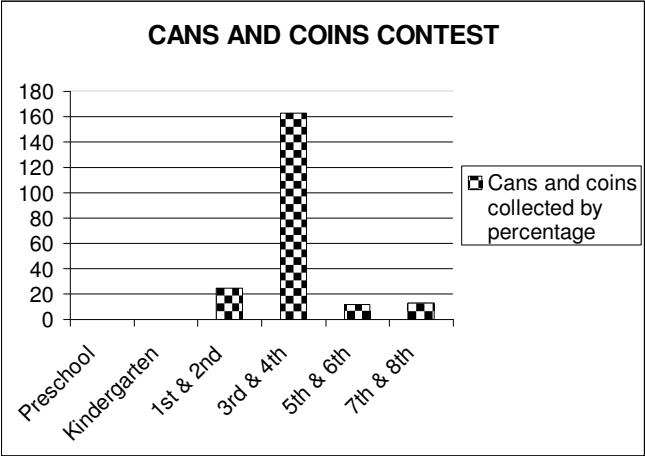


**CANS AND COINS CONTEST:**
